Construction Update

Starting on Monday there will be "micropiling" done which will be noisy but the least disruptive to our Home. Micropiling is a foundation technique that uses small-diameter, drilled and grouted piles to transfer structural loads down to stronger soil or rock. Unlike traditional large-diameter piles that are hammered into the ground, micropiles are installed by drilling a borehole, inserting steel reinforcement, and filling the hole with high-strength cement grout. They're especially valued for tight spaces, difficult ground conditions, and projects near existing structures where vibration and noise would cause problems.

Parking on the North side - New Spots and Construction Road

For Safety you are required to park backed into the spots located at the entrance. Additionally, the fenced area has a gravel roadway that is for construction access only. Please ensure you follow the signs and the construction workers' directions. This is for your safety.
