Reporting to the Manager of Recreation and Volunteers, the Recreologist will provide Recreation and Leisure activities to residents according to their assessed needs.

The Recreologist is required to perform their duties in a manner consistent with the core values of the Home and collaborate with all other clinical care providers to optimize the resident's experience.

Duties include:

Contribute to a plan of care to meet resident's individual recreation and leisure needs.

Identify appropriate therapeutic recreation goals and interventions on the care plan.

Develop, implement and evaluate recreation programs.

Responsible for maintain accurate and completed activity records.

Assist in orientation, assessment and supervision of college, university and high school students and volunteers.

Plan activities for resident in their assigned area based on the care plan, goals and activity calendar.

Organize and host large special events with the Home.

Contributes to positive customer service with residents and families on a day to day basis.
