UPDATE TO ALL FAMILY AND FRIENDS

St. Pat's does not have any positive cases for residents. The outbreak continues however as there was a positive staff result from the weekend. Once the outbreak is over we will still need to maintain physical distancing between residents as the pandemic continues.

As always, we continue to identify residents who have both typical and atypical symptoms and collect swabs for testing. This will be an ongoing process and we are always awaiting swab results. The POA for the resident being tested will be notified of both the swab being done and the results.

The recreation team has started small group activities on the resident home areas and will also be looking at physical distancing activities at resident doorways. We don't have over bed tables like would be seen in hospitals and we would appreciate donations of small folding tables (TV table style) so that we can set these up in the hallway and have residents at their doorways using the tables. This would facilitate some social interaction but maintain physical distancing between residents. Hallway sing along or hallway bingo! If you have anything that you can donate, please drop them off between the front doors with your name on the table. We will make sure that they are disinfected and brought to the residents.
