## **UPDATE TO ALL FAMILY AND FRIENDS**

Hello, there are no positive test results at St. Pat's.

The garden visits continued on the weekend and although it was a hot weekend there was enough shade to keep everyone protected. We are providing water for the residents in the garden. Please do not bring any food or drinks into the garden. You will need to leave your mask on for the visit so eating and drinking will be impossible!

The visits require a few steps and we appreciate your patience:

- All visitors must attest to having a negative Covid19 test completed in the past 2 weeks
- Visitors are 'actively' screened when entering which means:
  - Your temperature will be taken and must be under 37.8 degrees C
  - The volunteer will read a number of questions to you regarding your health status
  - The volunteer will provide education on hand hygiene techniques

These are the same screening protocols used for staff and if you fail any part of the screening you will not be permitted to visit on that date for the safety of the residents. Another visit will be rescheduled as soon as possible based upon the available schedules.

Unfortunately, the visits will be need to be cancelled in extreme weather conditions (eg. thunder storm, heavy rain, temperature in the garden above 32C in shaded areas).

If you are bringing in any parcels to drop off, please continue to bring these to the front door for drop off.
