UPDATE TO FAMILY AND FRIENDS

Hello, we remain Covid19 free as of today.

As mentioned yesterday, the hairdressing service will resume in a modified manner on July 6. Jo-anne Clarke has identified that she will make every attempt to follow the previous schedule with the regular clients who used her hairdressing service within the physical distancing requirements. Weekly appointments will not be possible right now. Please call the hair salon's extension 228 and leave a message for Jo-anne regarding all hairdressing services.

LTC homes who are not in outbreak are now proceeding with admissions, so St. Pat's will be having new people move in. The residents who were in hospital while we were in outbreak have now moved home. The first admission priority is any resident who was discharged due to the pandemic, and we do have one person who is returning this week. New admissions will start this week as well. All people moving back to St. Pat's or any new person moving in are Covid19 tested and move in within 24 hours of a negative test result. They will then be on isolation precautions for 14 days. We know that moving to LTC during a pandemic and needing to remain in their room is not going to be easy for these people or their families. I know that our kind and compassionate staff will do everything they can to make these new people feel welcome.

The next update will be on Thursday, July 2, 2020, following Canada Day.
