UPDATE TO ALL FAMILY AND FRIENDS

Hello, we remain Covid19 free today.

With the hot and humid weather over this past week we have unfortunately had to cancel a number of garden visits. The weather forecast says we will see the hot weather for another day or so and then we will see rain. We have some shelter in the garden so we can proceed if there is rain but we would cancel if there are thunderstorms in the area. Reception will call to let you know if a visit must be cancelled due to extreme weather conditions.

Yesterday the provincial government extended the emergency orders in the province until July 22, 2020. We have not been provided yet with any information on how this impacts LTC homes but will keep you informed as we hear any further direction.

And the good news for today is that the Ministry of LTC has notified LTC Homes that there will be a freeze on the long-term care resident co-payment rates for six months. The annual increase that would have gone into effect on July 1, 2020 will now be January 1, 2021.
