Subject: COVID-19 Outbreak at St. Patrick's Home – Resident Case

To whom it may concern,

It was reported that a resident of St. Patrick's Home tested positive for COVID-19 on 01 August 2020. I am writing this letter to confirm that Public Health Ontario Laboratory has amended this report.

The amended lab report received by St. Patrick's Home on 05 August 2020 states to disregard the previous positive result dated 01 August 2020. COVID-19 was **not detected**. There are currently no residents diagnosed with COVID-19 at St. Patrick's Home.

This does not change the outbreak status at the facility, as one staff member has tested positive for COVID-19. The expected termination date will be changed to **11 August 2020**, if no new cases arise.
