UPDATE TO ALL FAMILY AND FRIENDS

Hello, we have been notified that another person who worked on Dublin has had a positive test as part of the surveillance testing done last week. All of the most recent cases have been people who are asymptomatic, and we hope that they remain symptom free. Thankfully the three people only worked on one home area each, limiting the impact. This is the reasons that we are keeping staff assignments to one or two home areas.

Dublin will now also be on full isolation precautions, with residents eating in their rooms. Staff and visitors are required to wear gowns, gloves, masks and eye protection. The residents on Dublin will also be tested as part of the surveillance protocols.

We are still awaiting test results from the surveillance testing last week for the staff and are hopeful that we only get negative test results. The goal of the surveillance testing is to identify anyone who may be positive and implement the necessary infection and prevention protocols to prevent further spread. Keep positive thoughts for negative results.
