UPDATE TO ALL FAMILY AND FRIENDS

Hello, there are no further positive cases today.

We are continuing on a daily basis to have discussions with Ottawa Public Health to review what the infection prevention and control requirements for the isolation precautions within the Home on different home areas. We know that Carlow and Waterford will be on full isolation, with residents in their rooms for meals and all staff and visitors wearing gowns, masks and eye protection.

The status for Donegal, Dublin and Kerry is currently also full precautions, but we continue to have further discussion with Ottawa Public Health to review whether there can be some modification to the isolation protocols. We want to ensure that we balance the infection prevention and control requirements against resident isolation and meal service options.

All other home areas (Wexford, Galway, Cavan and Kilkenny) continue to have some precautions in place with the use of masks and eye protection, residents remaining on their home area and not going throughout the building, including outside for walks.

As soon as we have some further information from Ottawa Public Health we will provide this in an update.
