UPDATE TO ALL FAMILY AND FRIENDS

Hello, this afternoon we have received a positive test result from a resident on Donegal. This is unsettling for everyone, families, residents and staff. We are in contact with Public Health and have informed them of this positive test.

All of the family members of the residents on Donegal have been notified. All of the residents on Donegal are being swabbed and we will await the results.

The residents will now be served their meals in their rooms and asked to remain in their rooms. Some of the residents have sitters to support them to stay in their rooms.

Designated caregivers can continue to visit one person at a time, using full PPE of gown, mask and eye protection.

Residents on Wexford remain on isolation precautions and everyone uses a gown, mask and eye protection due to the positive case earlier this week. We will be re-testing the resident who had contact with the sitter from Wexford on Sunday. If the result is negative, all Wexford residents can be removed from being in isolation.

All of the other home areas will continue to use droplet precaution (masks and eye protection) and continue with dining room service as per the schedule.

There will be an update if there is new information to communicate before Monday, Nov. 9, otherwise our next update will be on Monday.
