UPDATE TO ALL FAMILY AND FRIENDS

Hello, we have no further positive results.

Public Health has now determined that Kilkenny must remain on full isolation precautions due to the one positive sitter case from last week. We will be continuing our discussion with them on the rationale for this decision, as well as advocating for alternative approaches. Unfortunately, while we remain in outbreak, hairdressing services and residents being able to attend at Mass are restricted.

Ottawa remains in an orange-restrict designation. Many of the current limitations in place within all long term care homes such as resident outings being prohibited, only two designated caregivers being able to visit, full restriction of all general visitors and confirmation of a negative Covid19 result in the past seven days are in place due to the orange-restrict designation and not due to the outbreak status. These limitations will continue even when we are confirmed to be out of outbreak and will continue until Ottawa's designation changes to a lower level.

We will keep you informed of any changes as we continue to advocate for the residents.
