UPDATE TO ALL FAMILY AND FRIENDS

Hello, we have no further positive Covid19 results and have received all but three of the results from the resident swabs done on Wednesday on Kilkenny. When we receive these results we should be out of suspect outbreak!

The Family Council has provided feedback on the garden schedule. Their suggestion is that a shorter time for all residents to access the garden daily would be preferred. A new schedule is included in today's email and is also available on our website: <https://stpats.ca/wp-content/uploads/2020/12/Garden-Access-Schedule-Dec.-12-Jan.-24.pdf> This new schedule is more condensed with 10 time slots daily. Therefore, each home area has one time per day, every day and one home area will have two time slots.

The garden will be open for one home area for a 20 minute period with a 10 minute period for people to travel to and from the garden. Ottawa Public Health agreed to allowing these garden walks as long as there is only one home area at a time in the garden to limit the interaction between residents from different home areas, therefore reducing the risk of spread of the virus across the home. This schedule will be in effect as of Saturday December 12th.

We will send an update if there is any change to the suspect outbreak status over the weekend, but otherwise the next update will be on Monday December 16th.
