UPDATE TO ALL FAMILY AND FRIENDS

Hello, what an exciting day at St. Pat's! We are so pleased to let you know that the vaccinations for the residents has been completed today. There are currently 243 residents at St. Pat's and 234 received the first dose of the Pfizer vaccine. The second dose for those that received the vaccination will be on Jan. 29. Residents that were not vaccinated today will be vaccinated once the Moderna vaccine is available in Ottawa.

The isolation precautions on Dublin have now been lifted as there were no positive cases. Kilkenny should be off of full isolation precautions as of tomorrow, as long as there are no outstanding swab results. We are hopeful that Ottawa Public Health will declare the outbreak over tomorrow. Once again positive thoughts and prayers for no additional cases!

We are so thankful to the team from Ottawa Public Health and the Ottawa Paramedic Services who arrived to deliver the vaccination to the residents. The staff at St. Pat's played a key role in supporting residents and the teams to make sure that the residents were able to get the vaccination.
