UPDATE TO ALL FAMILY AND FRIENDS

Hello, once again we had an exciting day at St. Pat's on Saturday January 30th with the second doses of the vaccination being given to 225 residents. The Paramedics are always very careful with the vaccine and were able to preserve doses for some additional people while they were in the building. Therefore, 17 staff and 11 Designated Caregivers who were due for their second dose were able to be vaccinated as well. This was a last minute bonus for these people as it was not planned given the number of potential doses available is never known until the residents are fully vaccinated.

There are a few residents who were not able to get their second dose on Saturday and a few who are not due for the second dose until later this week. We will be working with Public Health and the Paramedics to determine when these residents can get their second doses. We have no information on the second doses for staff or designated caregivers at this time. Just a reminder please update Reception when you are able to get your vaccination or when an appointment has been rescheduled, as I know that many appointments have been changed.

There are no additional positive cases at St. Pat's today.
