## **UPDATE TO ALL FAMILY AND FRIENDS**

Hello, we have no additional positive cases. The resident case is now considered resolved and the one remaining sitter case will be resolved tomorrow. If all goes as hoped and there are no further positive cases, the outbreak should be declared over by Ottawa Public Health (OPH) on February 10<sup>th</sup>.

The vaccination schedule remains unknown at this time, although we have been told that for the remaining few residents who have not yet had their second shot, they should receive the second dose within 28 days of the first. The specific date is not yet known but will let you know as soon as we have been scheduled.

Yesterday we received this message from Ottawa Public Health:

### ***Staff & Essential Caregivers:***

***Our team will be calling all staff and essential caregivers today and tomorrow (February 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup>) to offer appointments for 2nd dose vaccinations at the TOH clinic.***

These calls are being done by OPH separate from St. Pat's, so please let Reception know when your second shot is scheduled for our tracking. This will include those who received their first shot at St. Pat's on January 16<sup>th</sup> at St. Pat's.
