UPDATE TO ALL FAMILY AND FRIENDS

Hello, there have been no further positive results.

We have received all of the results from the second round of resident testing on Carlow and all are negative. The residents who had close contact will remain on additional precautions for 14 days from contact which will be until April 27th.

The results for the first resident tests for Donegal have been received except one. All are negative. Those residents who had close contact will be re-tested after 7-10 days from exposure, which will be on April 22nd or 23rd. They will stay on precautions for 14 days from contact which is until April 30th.

The residents on Galway, who had potential contact were tested and all the results are negative. They will be tested again in 7-10 days, which will be on April 22nd or 23rd. There are no isolation precautions as the contact is not considered a close contact. The testing is being done as an extra precaution.
