## **UPDATE TO ALL FAMILY AND FRIENDS**

Hello, we have no positive Covid 19 cases.

The changes outlined in the Monday update are now in place. I know that there will be a period of adjustment but so far things seem to be going well. The screening staff will support you in these guidelines. Thank you for your cooperation.

Just a few reminders of previous guidelines to make everything work well:

1. Masks are still required at all times indoors and outdoors.
2. Shift change from 2:30pm to 3:15pm is a busy time at screening, and it is best to avoid visiting at that time. Please try to schedule your visit so you do not arrive during this timeframe.
3. Rapid testing staff require a break in the day. They try to go at 12:30 to 1:00 pm and 5:30 to 6:00 pm, however if they are waiting for a result they will not be able to leave right on time and will be delayed in returning. We cannot predict if someone will arrive for a rapid test at 12:25 pm. so the rapid testing staff might not be able to get to their lunch until 12:40 and will therefore be delayed in returning. We thank you for your patience and respect for the staff.
