UPDATE TO ALL FAMILY AND FRIENDS

Hello, there are a total of 10 residents on Carlow and Cavan who are currently in isolation due to close contact with a positive case. All have had a PCR test completed and the results are all negative. The last contact with the positive case was on Sunday, June 6th, therefore the isolation precautions will end on June 21, 2021 assuming no further positive cases.

Rapid Testing Schedule

The rapid testing schedule will be adjusted slightly to ensure that all of the tests can be completed prior to the staff going for their break. Given the 15 minute period from the swab to reading the test result, the last swab will be done at 12:15pm. and 5:15 pm. The results can then be read and the staff break can proceed at the scheduled times from 12:30 to 1:00pm. and from 5:30 to 6:00pm. Thank you for your patience and support of the staff.

Visiting

Please remember that **all** visitors, both indoors and outside must wear a mask at all times. Those who are not fully vaccinated (both doses) should also be wearing eye protection. If you have a concern about anyone and visiting please let the screeners know and they can assist in clarifying.

General visitors **must** screen before meeting a resident outside. There have been general visitors meeting residents outside without screening. Unfortunately, this puts residents at risk as well as staff and other visitors. Please let your family and friends know that they need to screen before visiting with residents.

In total, outside there can be 4 visitors with a resident, 2 designated caregivers and a maximum of 2 general visitors. In the garden we are limiting this to 3 in total, but again it is a maximum of 2 general visitors.
