

**Seeking External Advisory Members to the Board of Directors of St.  
Patrick's Home of Ottawa**  
in relation to  
**Planning for an Affordable Apartment Building for Seniors at St Patrick's  
Home of Ottawa**

St. Patrick's Home of Ottawa has a long and proud history. Founded two years before Confederation, it is one of the oldest homes for the aged in Ontario.

In late 2013, St. Patrick's Home moved to a new state-of-the-art building at 2865 Riverside Drive. The home currently provides care and services for 288 long term care residents.

For the past few years the Board of Directors of St. Patrick's Home has been exploring how to expand and provide services for seniors in the wider community, outside of long term care. As part of supporting people to remain in the community for as long as possible St. Patrick's Home is currently in the process of planning the construction of an affordable living apartment building for seniors. In addition to housing, this apartment building would provide for a continuum of care and health care services, from independence through to assisted living.

**To assist with the planning for the construction of this supportive and affordable living apartment building with approximately 133 units, St Patrick's Home is inviting applications for volunteer External Advisory Members to the Corporate Development Committee of the Board of Directors.**

St Patrick's home is seeking individuals with expertise in planning, design or construction of commercial properties or housing projects. The preferred applicant's background would be in the areas of architecture, engineering, construction, project management and/or operating a similar type of facility.
