## **UPDATE TO ALL FAMILY AND FRIENDS**

Hello, we have now received the PCR Covid-19 result for the vaccinated staff member and it is positive. We wish them well.

Now that we have this result, the direction from Ottawa Public Health is that those residents who had close contact with the staff member will have a PCR test completed today. They and their family members have been notified. The residents will be on droplet/contact precautions which requires everyone entering their room, in addition to a mask, to wear eye protection and a gown and gloves. These residents are on isolation and therefore will be provided meals in their room.

The residents will have a PCR test completed today and repeated on November 3<sup>rd</sup>. If all tests are negative for Covid-19, they will be out of isolation precautions on November 6<sup>th</sup>.

Designated caregivers can continue to visit while these residents are on droplet/contact precautions, however, general visitors are restricted for those residents.

The other residents on Kerry will be able to continue with normal activities.

We will provide our regular update on November 3<sup>rd</sup> unless there is new information or changes.
