## **UPDATE TO ALL FAMILY AND FRIENDS**

Hello, unfortunately we had a positive swab result yesterday for a resident on Waterford. They had tested negative previously but due to symptoms was tested again and was found to be positive. They will be in isolation as will their table mates. The table mates will also be tested immediately and then early next week. All of their families are notified. All staff, visitors and designated caregivers must wear full PPE (masks and eye protection at all times and gowns when in isolation rooms) on Waterford.

As a reminder to everyone on all home areas, masks must be worn at all times by staff, visitors and designated caregivers. Unfortunately, visitors and designated caregivers cannot share a meal or treats together with a resident, however the resident can certainly enjoy these while we keep our mask on.

A few other reminders:

- Please do not visit if you are not feeling well.
- Wash your hands regularly.
- Keep physically distanced from other residents.
- Do not visit other resident rooms.

### Parking

The parking lot adjacent to our lot will have spaces for designated staff members to park. We are not asking designated caregivers or visitors to park there, only staff. New visitor parking spaces will soon be identified to support families and visitors with additional parking.
