UPDATE TO ALL FAMILY AND FRIENDS

Hello,

On January 18th, the majority of residents in isolation on Kilkenny and Dublin were finished their 10 day isolation period and are off of isolation. Hurray! Today the residents on Kerry are now off of isolation as well. HURRAY!

Unfortunately, there was a positive rapid test result from a student this morning who worked on Kilkenny and some of the residents will need to isolate again. We also had a positive result from a staff member on Donegal and there are residents who are close contact. The families of residents who are a close contact and now on isolation will be notified.

One step forward and one step backward!

Unfortunately, the other home areas have some residents remaining in isolation due to close contacts, and these isolation precautions will be lifted at various dates based upon the date of close contact.

As of today, there are currently 2 residents who are positive and not yet resolved as they are doing their 10 day isolation period and there are 21 staff who are off as they tested positive and are doing their 10 day isolation. There is one caregiver who is positive and completing their isolation and today the student who is positive. All of the other positive cases are resolved and staff have returned to work. These numbers fluctuate daily as there are people who have completed their 10 day isolation and therefore are resolved but unfortunately new people who are positive.

As always, there is an ongoing assessment of residents for any symptoms and whenever a resident has any symptoms they are placed on isolation and tested.

We remain in whole home outbreak with each home area in different stages of isolation for the residents.
