UPDATE TO ALL FAMILY AND FRIENDS

Hello, since the last update on Monday we have had 2 designated caregivers test positive on rapid tests, and their loved one is now in isolation. We also had a staff member test positive but there was no resident close contact so there are no residents affected.

Yesterday a staff member who worked on Kerry tested positive on a rapid test. There are 10 residents who were close contacts and unfortunately will have to isolate for 10 days.

Three of the residents who were Covid19 positive are now resolved. Wexford is now fully off of isolation.

Donegal has one resident on isolation due to a close contact. The other residents are now off of isolation.

There are residents who continue on isolation on Carlow, Galway and Waterford. These isolation precautions will end on various dates, based upon the date of the close contact or positive test result.

We currently have 5 active resident cases and 8 active staff cases.

Parking

We are noticing that people are parking outside the 'lines' which means that we are losing parking spots. Please take notice of the parking spot 'lines' when they are visible and keep within these lines. It will help with access to the available parking spots.

The parking enforcement has resumed in the parking lot and tickets will be given for parking in the fire lanes. This is a safety issue for everyone.
