## **UPDATE TO ALL FAMILY AND FRIENDS**

Hello, unfortunately there was a student who tested positive on a rapid test this weekend and therefore the outbreak continues. The new protocols for low risk contacts means that there are 4 residents who are being monitored and will be tested on day 5 from contact but they do not need to be in isolation. Their families have been notified.

Visiting is limited to 2 people at a time, except for those residents who are in isolation due to symptoms. As always when a resident has a symptom, they are placed in isolation and a swab is completed. They remain in isolation until a negative test result is received and symptom free. While someone is in isolation, visiting is limited to one person at a time.

Mass will resume in the Gathering Place for one home area per day. Mass will continue to be broadcast daily for everyone else.

As a reminder to designated caregivers, our rapid testing room operates from 8am to 8 pm. Testing is not available outside of these hours.

Access to the disabled parking spots has been a challenge in the past few weeks and therefore we have added some additional wheelchair parking spots. If you have a disabled parking pass, we are hopeful that this will provide better access. For everyone else please be mindful of these new spots and leave them for those who are eligible due to mobility limitations.
