UPDATE TO ALL FAMILY AND FRIENDS

There are two home areas that remain in outbreak, Dublin and Cavan. On Dublin we have had 2 of the high risk resident contacts test positive and there are 2 residents who are now considered resolved. There is a total of 4 resident cases on Dublin however 2 will be resolved as of tomorrow. Cavan has one resident who remains as a positive case but no additional resident cases.

Rapid testing continues to identify a few other staff, designated caregivers and support workers who are positive. In these cases, any resident who is considered a low risk contact is tested on day 5 following the contact and to date there has been no additional residents testing positive.

Recreation

There are some changes coming in the Recreation department as 2 staff members are leaving St. Pat's. Mitchell Haslam and Linda Casmir will be leaving in the next week or so. In order to provide coverage for recreation programs, the recreation staff coverage as of May 15 will be:

The goal is to have various programs running on all home areas at least 5 days per week.

We will recruit for new recreation staff but want to ensure that programming continues while we recruit, hire and on-board new staff members.
