UPDATE TO ALL FAMILY AND FRIENDS

St. Pat's is officially out of outbreak! Thank you to everyone who has continued to be vigilant and follow all of the infection prevention and control protocols. General visitors can now visit on Cavan.

There are fewer community cases now, and we are seeing a lower number of people testing positive on rapid tests. We are hopeful that this trend continues.

We continue to require staff to wear masks and eye protection when providing care to residents. The eye protection is to protect the person wearing them, and we recommend that all designated caregivers and general visitors wear them as extra protection. If a resident is Covid19 positive and you have visited without eye protection you will be considered a close contact and will therefore be restricted from visiting for 10 days. If you have your eye protection on you are a low risk contact and will not have visiting restricted.

It is great to see people enjoying the warmer weather and would like to remind everyone that St. Pat's is requiring people to wear a mask outside as well as inside.

Also as a reminder, please do not eat or drink with a resident, as we all need to keep our mask on when in proximity of a resident. This is for their protection and safety. Thank you for ensuring that you are keeping your mask on at all times.
