UPDATE TO ALL FAMILY AND FRIENDS

Hello, we have had a suspect outbreak on Kilkenny with a resident who tested positive for Covid19 last week and has been isolating. Today, Kilkenny is in outbreak as 2 staff have tested positive. All of the other residents on Kilkenny are considered low risk contacts and do not require isolation precautions. One of the staff also worked on Dublin and there are some residents on Dublin who are also considered low risk contacts and their families will be notified. Any resident who is considered a low risk contact will be tested on day 5 following contact. Dublin is not considered in outbreak.

Outbreak precautions for Kilkenny:

- One designated caregiver may visit at a time.
- All designated caregivers must wear eye protection on Kilkenny
- General visitors for Kilkenny cannot visit during the outbreak

Although the numbers of cases in Ottawa are decreasing, Covid19 remains a reality and a risk for the residents at St. Pat's.

Please follow all of the infection prevention and control protocols, wear your mask, practice good hand hygiene, keep physically distanced. **Masks are required at all times both in the building and on the grounds.**
