UPDATE TO ALL FAMILY AND FRIENDS

Hello, we remain in outbreak on Kilkenny. There are currently two residents who are in isolation due to Covid19 and one resident who is resolved and now off of isolation. There is one staff member who remains off due to Covid19 with two who are now resolved. The other residents on Kilkenny and Dublin have had their PCR test and all results received are negative. We are waiting for one more result at this time.

Transportation from hospital

We have been having some challenges with transportation companies bringing people back from hospital as the transportation company staff's vaccination status does not meet our requirement. We have informed the transportation companies and hospitals that their staff must have 3 Covid19 vaccinations to enter St. Pat's, just like the staff, designated caregivers and visitors. Unfortunately, we have had situations where the transportation staff are not fully vaccinated, which means that a resident remains in the lobby for an extended wait while we try and sort out options for getting the resident back to their room. If your loved one is returning from hospital, could you assist as well in discussion with the hospital or the transportation company in informing them that the staff must have 3 Covid19 vaccinations to enter St. Pat's. We will also remind them if we get notice that a resident is returning. We do not always get advanced notice but the more people reminding will greatly support a smooth transition back to St. Pat's for the resident.
