UPDATE TO ALL FAMILY AND FRIENDS

Hello,

Carlow remains in outbreak. There are 10 residents who have tested positive in total over the past 10 days.

Donegal is now also in outbreak as of yesterday and there are 5 residents who have now tested positive.

Thankfully the residents who are positive are doing fairly well with some symptoms but as they are vaccinated they are more protected from serious illness.

On the outbreak home areas, designated caregivers are able to visit, however, general visitors are not able to visit while in outbreak.

Galway is in suspect outbreak as one resident has tested positive. There are no restrictions on visiting at this time.

Over the past couple of weeks, we have had an increasing number of people - staff, sitters, designated caregivers and visitors who have tested positive. There are staff who are in isolation both related to the outbreak, but also due to community contacts. This is a challenge for everyone and certainly reminds us that the community is experiencing an increase of Covid19.

We all need to ensure that we are following all of the Infection Prevention and Control protocols to protect ourselves, each other and the residents.
