## **UPDATE TO ALL FAMILY AND FRIENDS**

Hello,

The Covid19 status at St. Pat's is continually changing with some resident cases being resolved and some additional cases identified in residents, staff and designated caregivers.

**Please follow all of the infection prevention and control protocols as the cases in the community continue to be at very high levels.**

Carlow remains in outbreak although there are no new resident cases. As long as there are no further positive cases associated with Carlow, the outbreak on Carlow will be over on Saturday, August 13.

Donegal has 4 residents who are now resolved however a new resident has tested positive. In total there are now 7 residents on Donegal who are positive. As of tomorrow, an additional 5 will be resolved therefore 2 will remain as positive.

Dublin remains in outbreak with one new resident case since Monday. There are 9 positive residents on Dublin.

Kerry remains in outbreak. Two additional residents have tested positive therefore there are now 3 resident cases on Kerry.

Wexford is in suspect outbreak with one resident case identified with no additional cases identified.

### **Geotechnical Services on Site**

On August 11, 12, 15, and 16<sup>th</sup> you will see some equipment and activity on site. We are doing some soil sample testing as well as studies of the ground water. This is information needed to determine the feasibility of building senior housing on our site in the future.

There are 7 boreholes being drilled on these 4 days. The drilling will have a similar noise level as the drilling completed last month which was minimal. The drill crew will set up an exclusion zone around the drill rig. The drill rig will remain on site until the site work is finished, so the rig will remain on site overnight/over the weekend.
