UPDATE TO ALL FAMILY AND FRIENDS

Hello, we remain outbreak free at St. Pat's. Please continue with all the infection prevention and control processes in place to protect the people who live here.

Although there are decreased protocols in the broader community, LTC Homes are required to follow the following process:

- Staff, designated caregivers, visitor and volunteers must continue to wear masks in the home and on the grounds at all time. Consequently, family and friends may not eat or drink with a resident, either in the building, or on the grounds. Family and friends may bring in food and drink for a resident's enjoyment, but you cannot partake, as you must remain masked for the duration of the visit.
- Eye protection is recommended for designated caregivers and visitors when in close contact with residents.
- Rapid testing continues for everyone entering St. Pat's on every second day.
