UPDATE TO ALL FAMILY AND FRIENDS

Hello, the whole home Covid19 outbreak continues with some home areas seeing a decline in the number of cases.

The following is the status as of today. These numbers change daily as resident cases are resolved but we have also seen a couple of new positive resident cases.

Cavan – 1
Donegal – 3
Wexford – 5
Waterford – 9
Galway – 9
Kilkenny – 2

Designated caregivers can continue to visit COVID positive residents and must wear the required PPE including masks, eye protection, gowns and gloves and stay in the resident's room for the entire visit. Visiting other residents on those house areas by designated caregivers can continue as well, with eye protection as well as masks. Although the Ministry has indicated that designated caregivers can remove their mask in resident rooms, **we are strongly recommending that masks be worn at all times** during the outbreak.

General visitors may not visit while we are in whole home outbreak.
