Hello, there are no Covid19 cases at this time in the Home.

Although the provincial directive identifies that designated caregivers may remove their mask when visiting in a resident room, we **strongly recommend leaving your mask on** when in close contact with a resident. This protects the resident from all of the circulating respiratory illnesses.
