Hello, we remain outbreak free at St. Pat's!

New Linen Delivery Process:

Starting in the next few weeks, we'll be implementing a new process for delivering linen to resident rooms. Here's what you need to know:

Each resident will have their own 3-tier cart for face cloths and hand towels. This will make it easier for residents to access their linens whenever they need them and ensure we have plenty of inventory.

Our laundry team will restock these carts twice a week, ensuring a 4-day supply. We'll also have regular carts for bath towels, sheets, pillowcases, and blankets.

Personal laundry services will change from every 24 hour delivery to every 48 hours, to accommodate the new deliveries. We understand some residents don't have a lot of clothing and we will deal with this.

Front Entrance Access:

Many of you have noticed that the front doors to St. Pats are now locked and reception opens them as you arrive. This is the pre-covid process to ensure safety and security of our building. Family members with their own badges are encouraged to bring them each visit as they give you access to open the door.
