Time Commitment: The Board and each Committee meets a minimum of five times per calendar year with additional meetings as required. Materials are distributed one week prior to meetings and meetings typically run from 5pm – 7pm. The meetings are currently being held via Zoom or in person when possible.

Applications are being accepted on an ongoing basis via email per the instructions in the Board of Directors Application. The Governance and Nominating Committee will review all applications as they are received. Applicants selected for an interview will be contacted. Interviews will be scheduled as applications are reviewed and candidates will be notified of the timeline for the appointment process during the interview.
