### **Power Conversion**

We have initiated the process of converting the ceiling lift power source to operate on our emergency power system. This is aimed at ensuring that during power outages, the ceiling lifts remain operational in all resident rooms. The conversion process necessitates temporarily relocating residents from their rooms for approximately one hour, allowing technicians to carry out the necessary modifications. Like the lift installation, we will be scheduling these conversions by home area. The process will be coordinated with the nursing staff on each RHA based on the residents' routines.

We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause and want to assure you that we will make every effort to minimize disruptions during this period. Your understanding and cooperation are greatly appreciated. If you have any concerns or specific preferences regarding the scheduling of this conversion in your area, please feel free to communicate them with us.
