UPDATE TO ALL FAMILY AND FRIENDS

Hello, happy to report that St. Pat's has no outbreak at this time.

The Ministry of Long Term Care (MLTC) is ending the required masking measures effective immediately March 4, 2024:

Masking in non-outbreak situations in LTCHs continues to be:

1. Staff, students, volunteers, and support workers:

- Masks are required based on a point of care risk assessment (PCRA) before every resident interaction, and based on the return-to-work protocols
- Staff may consider wearing a mask during prolonged direct resident care defined as one-on-one within two metres of an individual for fifteen minutes or longer
- Masks are not required in administrative and staff-only areas (for example: lunchrooms, breakroom, offices, and gyms)

2. Caregivers and visitors:

• Masks are recommended, but not required, in all areas of the home
