Hello,

We are currently still in respiratory outbreak on Kilkenny and Wexford. Cavan and Dublin have all been declared outbreak free by Public Health.

Solar Eclipse – April 8th

A great phenomenon will be occurring on April 8th called the Solar Eclipse. It will be occurring between **2:11 pm to 4:35 pm.** The time frame it will be over Ottawa will be from 3:22 to 3:28 with the peak hitting us at 3:25 pm. During the eclipse, the experts tell us, not to look at the sun directly at any time as it may damage your sight. The only way you can safely see it is to have special solar eclipse glasses that are certified with specialized filters adhering to the ISO 12312-2 international standard.

During this time, it will be all hands on deck at St. Pat's to ensure the safety of our residents:

- We will be drawing/closing all the curtains in the home at 2 pm
- For the residents that will be up during this time, we will invite them to the dining room to experience a solar eclipse education session with the recreation staff
- For the residents who choose not to attend, we will ensure that during this time they are not trying to go outside or are looking outside
- We will have a select amount of the special solar eclipse glasses available for the residents who wish to view the eclipse

We are appreciative of your co-operation in assisting us to keep the residents safe during this time.
