### **Outbreak Status**

We are currently outbreak free.

### **Parking Clarification**

We do offer off-site parking for our staff. We pay an additional \$6000 a month for this off-site parking to offer more visitor parking. We also do not allow our students to park in the parking lot.

We have to have clear roadways for emergency vehicles such as fire trucks and ambulances. We receive large transportation vehicles that deliver food and equipment to the home and have no place to turn around or back up when the lanes are obstructed. In addition to that, we have garbage and recycling pick up.

The peak time that there is little to no parking is during 2pm to 3:30pm, when a large majority of our staff leave and a large majority of the staff are coming in. After 3:30pm there is always plenty of parking.

These are the measures already in place to maximize the parking spaces, but if there is no parking, you unfortunately, will have to wait until a spot becomes available.
