### **Beauty Salon Price Increases**

Please note that the Beauty Salon prices will be increasing by \$2.00 per service effective June 1, 2026. For instance, a wash, cut and set/blow dry will be increasing from the current price of \$45.00 to \$47.00. Prices for Beauty Salon services have not increased in three years. Martin will be posting the new price list on the salon door.

### **Fire Safety/Alarms**

As a part of our Emergency Preparedness Plan, we conduct fire drills on a regular basis on all shifts. This ensures all staff know what their role is when the fire alarm goes off and helps them to be prepared in the case of an actual fire. In addition, staff are trained about "Code Red" procedures upon hire and annually thereafter. **But, what is the role of caregivers/visitors during a fire alarm?** When you hear the fire alarm, please:

- Follow instructions from staff members and stay where you are until further notice.
- Do not attempt to use the elevators or stairways, or to transport yourself or other residents on your own.
- When the alarm sounds, the fire doors close automatically. Only emergency services personnel and designated St. Pat's staff members are allowed to pass through these doors.
- Remain calm, stay where you are, listen to announcements and take direction from the staff members in charge. We ask residents, family members and other visitors to familiarize themselves with all fire exits (located at both ends of each floor and illuminated with EXIT signs) and fire alarm pull stations on each floor (located near exits).
