Outbreak Status

We are currently outbreak free!

Parking

Parking on-site is currently limited due to the construction, and we are actively working to secure additional off-site parking options for staff. While we have not been successful yet, efforts are ongoing. In the meantime, it is recommended that you avoid peak times. If possible, please plan your visits after 3:00pm, as this is when parking demand is at its lowest.

Just a reminder that we have a contract with parking enforcement and anyone who does not pay for parking or does not have a registered license plate with the home will be ticketed. These will be City of Ottawa parking fines.

There is to be no parking at the front entrance, this is a drop off and pick up only, as emergency vehicles are being blocked by vehicles parking at the front entrance.

There will be a grace period for staff during shift change between 2-3:30pm. Otherwise, all vehicles must be in a designated parking spot. Cars parked in the fire lanes or any undesignated parking space may be ticketed, regardless if having paid for parking or being registered. As well, vehicles without a visible accessible parking pass may be ticketed if parked in those designated spaces closest to the front entrance.
